## **CLINIC SERVICES**

Pediatrics: Head Start physicals, NIAA sports physicals, well child checks, sick child visits, immunizations.

Women's Health: Pap smears, pregnancy testing, gynecological exams, breast exams, STD testing, mammogram referrals.

Lab services: Cholesterol checks, blood glucose monitoring, and more (All patients needing lab services must first be seen by an SOC physician who will order any necessary tests.)

Preventive care: Immunizations available for all ages at all clinics.

Additional services: General physicals, EKGs, blood pressure monitoring, x-rays, and referrals.

**LOCATION**: All clinics are held at the Family Medicine Center on the University of Nevada, Reno campus. It is located at the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> St and East Stadium Way, directly northeast of the football stadium on the north side of the university campus. *Bus Route 7* to N Virginia St or the *free Sierra Spirit* bus will both take you there.
