PARTNER TOOLKIT **OVERVIEW**

TOOLKIT PURPOSE:

We want to help our partners communicate the benefits for Nevadans that come from The American Rescue Plan Act. This toolkit will contain messaging, best practices, amplification tools and sample posts for your social media channels.

GOAL:

The main goal is to show you how to best represent Nevada Health Link when communicating the benefits of The American Rescue Plan Act. We recommend that you do this by highlighting the facts and what it means for Nevadans.

POSTING SCHEDULE/FREQUENCY:

We recommend a rotating posting schedule, where each audience is addressed directly for one week at a time, with around 2-3 posts per week being distributed. For example, 2-3 posts with messaging targeted specifically at students would go out one week. The next week would then focus on parents, and so on.

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT **OVERVIEW**

OVERVIEW:

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (American Rescue Plan) lowers health insurance premiums. For Nevada residents, the American Rescue Plan reduces premiums for health insurance plans sold through Nevada Health Link. Additionally, those that qualified for unemployment in 2021 may pay as little as \$0/month and pays for 100% of COBRA premiums for laid-off workers.*

SINGLE BRAND IDEA:

Nevada Health Link connects individuals to a variety of insurance plans from different health insurance companies, as well as offers tools and resources to help you choose the plan that's right for you. Nevada Health Link is the only health insurance resource that can provide you with federal tax credits and subsidies to help cover the cost of your insurance.

TALKING POINTS

- Even if you already purchased a 2021 plan through Nevada Health Link, you may be eligible for more savings. And if you recently shopped plans, you should come back to see the new savings starting in late April.
- Now more than ever, we all want peace of mind. Because of the increased savings, the peace of mind that comes with having health insurance is within reach for many more Nevadans.

SOCIAL MEDIA BEST PRACTICES

THINGS TO DO

- Share high quality imagery.
- Keep messaging short, direct, and clear.
- Tell the story behind the images, make it relatable.
- Use images of that represent Nevada, (do not use stock photos that are not representative of the region)
- Keep platform crop factors in mind. Imagery that
 performs best on Facebook and Instagram tends to be
 vertical images (1:1 and 3:4). For Twitter, keep your
 images horizontal (1:2 or 16:9), as anything taller than
 that is cropped in the image preview.

THINGS TO AVOID

- Do not share PDFs or flyers on social media. If you feel
 the need to share messaging from these flyers then
 instead share a high quality photo and add the
 messaging within the copy of the post.
- Avoid low quality photos. Try and share larger high quality photos as small images will come across as pixelated and cheapen the image of your brand.
- Avoid sharing posts without a caption.
- Avoid hashtags on Facebook.
- Do not include website URLs on Instagram as they aren't clickable.

RECOMMENDED CONTENT



UPDATES

Showcase any updates released in press releases or trusted news outlets. Share content from credible sources that keep consumers up to date on deadlines, enrollments, and potential cost savings.

Things You Need to Enroll

Valid Nevada driver license or picture ID; students ID for dependent children

Permanent Resident/Alien registration card (if applicable)

Social Security cards and dates of birth for all tax household members

Proof of Nevada residence (i.e., phone or power bill)

Estimate of your household income

Three most recent paycheck stubs

Copy of any current health insurance information (employer information if job-based coverage)

ACTION ITEMS

Make sure to share necessary procedures that need to be followed to access services. Include necessary documentation and information needed to enroll and receive services.



FACTS

Share relevant facts about savings offered through the American Rescue Plan Act. Concise facts relevant to the consumers every day life spark interest and fuel an eagerness to enroll.

GRAPHIC OVERLAY




