- The Silver State Health Insurance Exchange is the state agency that operates the online marketplace, Nevada Health Link.
- We connect Nevadans who are not insured by their employer, Medicaid, or Medicare to comprehensive health insurance coverage.
- Individuals can purchase Affordable Care Act certified Qualified Health Plans or Qualified Dental Plans through the Exchange. If eligible they can receive subsidy assistance to help offset monthly premium costs.
- NevadaHealthLink.com is THE ONLY site Nevadans can get access to financial assistance.
- Solely self-funded no state and limited federal funds to support operations.


2022 Enrollment Plan Selections

Year-over-Year Enrollment







- Before the pandemic, the Guinn Center conducted a study that showed an estimated 350,000 – 400,000 or nearly 14%
 Nevadans were uninsured.
- Of those uninsured:
 - 37% were thought to be Medicaid/CHIP eligible
 - 19% were thought to be Exchange eligible with financial assistance (77K)
 - 12% were thought to be ineligible for exchange financial assistance because they had offer of affordable ESI.
 - 27% were ineligible for Exchange/Medicaid due to immigration status
 - 5% were ineligible for financial assistance because of income over 400% FPL (20K)
- The United States Census Bureau recently did an uninsured study, reporting Nevada's current uninsured rate is 11.6%

Important Dates

- October 1, 2022: "Window Shopping" available for anonymous plan comparison. Open to all Nevadans.
- November 1, 2022: OEP begins; Open Enrollment is Nov. 1, 2022 Jan. 15, 2023.
- Consumers who enroll thru Dec. 31, 2022, will have a coverage start date of Jan. 1, 2023.
- For those consumers who enroll from Jan. 1 Jan. 15, they will have a coverage start date of Feb. 1, 2023.
- Consumers who completed their application but haven't selected a plan by Jan 15th will be able to complete their enrollment between January 16-20, 2023.

Open Enrollment 2023

- 163 QHP Plans Seven Carriers
 - All seven carriers are returning; Aetna Health, Health Plan of Nevada, Silver Summit,
 Anthem HMO Nevada, SelectHealth, Hometown, and Friday Health Plans
 - Catastrophic; Bronze; Silver; Gold
 - Counties: Clark County and Nye County will have the choice from 104 plans offered from Aetna Health, Silver Summit, Anthem HMO Nevada, SelectHealth, Hometown, and Friday Health Plans
 - 88 plans are available in Washoe County from Aetna, Hometown Health Plan, HPN,,
 Anthem HMO Nevada, and Friday Health Plans.
 - 58 plans are available in Carson City and rural counties Douglas, Lyon, and Storey from Hometown Health Plan, SilverSummit, Anthem HMO Nevada, and Friday Health Plans.
 - 51 plans are available in Churchill, Elko, Esmeralda, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander, Lincoln, Mineral, Pershing, and White Pine
 - 18 Qualified Dental Plans Five dental carriers (Alpha, EMI, Delta, Best, and Rocky Mountain)
- The final average rate increase on-Exchange is 9.2%.
- 7 Navigator Grantees, 7 Broker grantees



2023 Renewals

- Most consumers were auto-renewed for Plan Year 2023.
- Consumers will be renewed into their existing plan, or cross-walked into a similar plan by late October.
- Consumers will have renewal notices have been delivered. Eligibility notices will be delivered within the next 48 hours.
- We always encourage people to shop the market – there are new plans and new rates!



Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)

- Thanks to the recently passed Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)
 this milestone achievement will extend the expansion of the
 premium tax credits on Affordable Care Act (ACA) plans
 outlined in the American Rescue Plan until 2025.
- IRA extended eligibility for ACA health insurance subsidies to people buying plans on Nevada Health Link who have incomes over 400% of poverty.
- The law also increases the amount of financial assistance for people at lower incomes who were already eligible for financial assistance.
 - People up to 150% of FPL can get silver plans for zero premiums and reduced deductibles.

PHE Unwinding


In 2020, The U.S. Department of Health & Human Services declared the U.S. to be in a Public Health Emergency (PHE). When the PHE ends (date yet to be determined), Nevadans enrolled in Medicaid will need to take action to renew their coverage and not lose health insurance. Nevada Health Link is working closely with Nevada Medicaid to inform Nevadans about renewing their coverage and exploring health insurance options if they no longer qualify for Medicaid.

- Kitchen table economics and inflation




- Unwinding of the Public Health Emergency
 - Please make sure anyone you know who is currently on Medicaid updates their contact information with the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS)
- DWSS Mailers
- Senate Bill 420 Public Option
- Assembly Bill 432 Automatic Voter Registration
- The Family Glitch
 - As a result of the Family Glitch, family members of workers —
 primarily low-income workers are ineligible to receive
 premium tax credits through the marketplace even when
 family coverage is unaffordable.
 - The Biden administration is actively working to fix the family glitch
 - Nevada Health Lin will have a calculator on the platform and provide fact sheets and learning materials when/ if the law is pasted.
