DR. JAMESON: Extra brief Board meeting and roll call by Ryan?

HIGH: Sure. Now if I could start with just a few housekeeping

If you would like to make a comment, please raise your electronic hand or indicate in the chat box that you would like to make a comment and Kaitlyn will unmute you. For those on the phone, please remember to mute yourselves or else we will hear your private conversations. Madam Chair, there may be people on the telephone that would like to make a public comment, so we just need to remember to ask if there are any public comments on the phone. We also have our Carson City Conference location open to the public so public comment may come from there as well. And for anyone speaking, a friendly reminder, please remember to state your name for the record before making a comment or presenting. Now take roll call. Okay. Dr.

DR. JAMESON: Present.

HIGH: Great. Ms. Valerie Clark?

CLARK: Present.

HIGH: Okay. Ms. Lavonne Lewis?

LEWIS: Present.

HIGH: Okay. Thank you. Dr. Friedman?

FRIEDMAN: Present.

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any discussion? As you have reviewed the minutes, are there any concerns of errors or omissions? Any additions required? And if not, then hearing nothing, we'll go ahead and take a vote. Everybody in favor just say aye. Everyone in favor, please say aye.

MEMBERS: Aye.

DR. JAMESON: Is there anyone opposed? Not hearing any opposition, anyone abstained? So very good, the minutes from our last Board meeting Thursday, February 16, 2023, Silver State Exchange are approved. Our next item, which is so exciting, is the approval of the Public Health Emergency Unwinding Special Enrollment period. I want to thank our staff who has worked so long and hard on this all last year with Medicaid officials and others to make this possible seamless transition and as you can see, we are now ready to make an official approval of the Public Health Emergency Unwinding Special Enrollment Period. Do I hear a motion to accept this?

JOHNSON: Jonathan Johnson, motion to approve.

DR. JAMESON: Second?

LEWIS: Second.

DR. JAMESON: Thank you, Lavonne. Everybody in favor of the approval of the Public Health Emergency Unwinding Special Enrollment, please say aye.

MEMBERS: Aye.

DR. JAMESON: Anyone opposed? Is there any abstaining? Thank you. I'm so happy to say that it has been approved by the Board for the Public Health Emergency Unwinding Special Enrollment Period, and it is indeed extremely exciting as there could be as much as a couple hundred thousand individuals who may be unrolled or unwinding or coming off over the next several months or year, and we will be there. We will be there for them. And thank you for the staff at the Exchange for just creating this wonderful process, all the notifications that you've been sending out and will be doing, and for helping these individuals who will no longer have the emergency public health. Thank you so much for helping them transition in this time

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of their need for insurance. As we know, health insurance is so important. That's why we're all here. You guys have really worked hard to make this happen so seamless. So thank you. And finally, something very exciting and new as we talked about in the last meeting and prior, which is the next item, the approval to revise the NRS 695I.300, to add two additional voting Board members to the Exchange Board of Directors to be appointed by the Governor for the purpose of the Tribal and minority population representation. And also, this is extremely exciting for the Exchange to be able to have these groups, the Tribal and minority population representation, on our Board, and I want to thank everybody that worked hard on this to make it happen. So let's go ahead and I'd ask for a motion to approve. And as you guys may know when you read this, this of course is pending. The potential addition of these members will be contingent upon the passage through the legislative process of the state of Nevada to amend the NRS and at this point, we're doing our part. So I would love to have a motion for the approval to revise the NRS 695I.300 for the two additional voting Board members to the Exchange Board of Directors.

BRANCH: Mr. Quincy Branch, so moved.

MELENDREZ: Jose, second.

JAMESON: Thank you, Quincy and Jose. So everybody at this point, if you'd like to have any discussion on this subject, we can discuss it. Hearing, no discussion, any questions, any further questions to be addressed by Ryan and our wonderful staff? Hearing none, then I would say, let's go ahead and take a vote. Everybody in favor of the approval of the revision of NRS 695I.300, two additional voting Board members to the Exchange Board of Directors to be appointed by the Governor for the purpose of a Tribal and minority population representative, please say aye.

MEMBERS: Aye.

DR. JAMESON: Anyone opposed? Anyone abstaining? Okay. Hearing none, that motion has passed unanimously. Thank you. I'm not sure if you heard me cause I was frozen, but that motion was passed unanimously. Thank you, everyone.

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At this point we can move with brevity and vigor to the discussion and possible actions regarding dates, times, and agenda items for our future meetings.

HIGH: If I may, Dr. Jameson, our next meeting is scheduled for June 22 at 1:30 PM unless determined there should be one before that time.

DR. JAMESON: Is that -- now I just want to clarify. June --

HIGH: June 22.

DR. JAMESON: Did you say 11? Eleven?

HIGH: 1:30.

DR. JAMESON: Oh, okay. Okay. So at 1:30 PM?

HIGH: Yes.

DR. JAMESON: All right. And so that's excellent. It's sort of drifting from the 12:30 to the 1:30 start.

HIGH: Yes.

DR. JAMESON: Okay. I'm very good with that. Is everybody on the Board, is that still good with everyone? We were kind of at the 12:30 an now and then at 1:00 today and now kind of down to 1:30. Does that work for everybody okay?

In the meantime, I just want to thank everybody for taking this extra time for this additional Board meeting today. DR. JAMESON: Excellent. Then I think we have wound up --
