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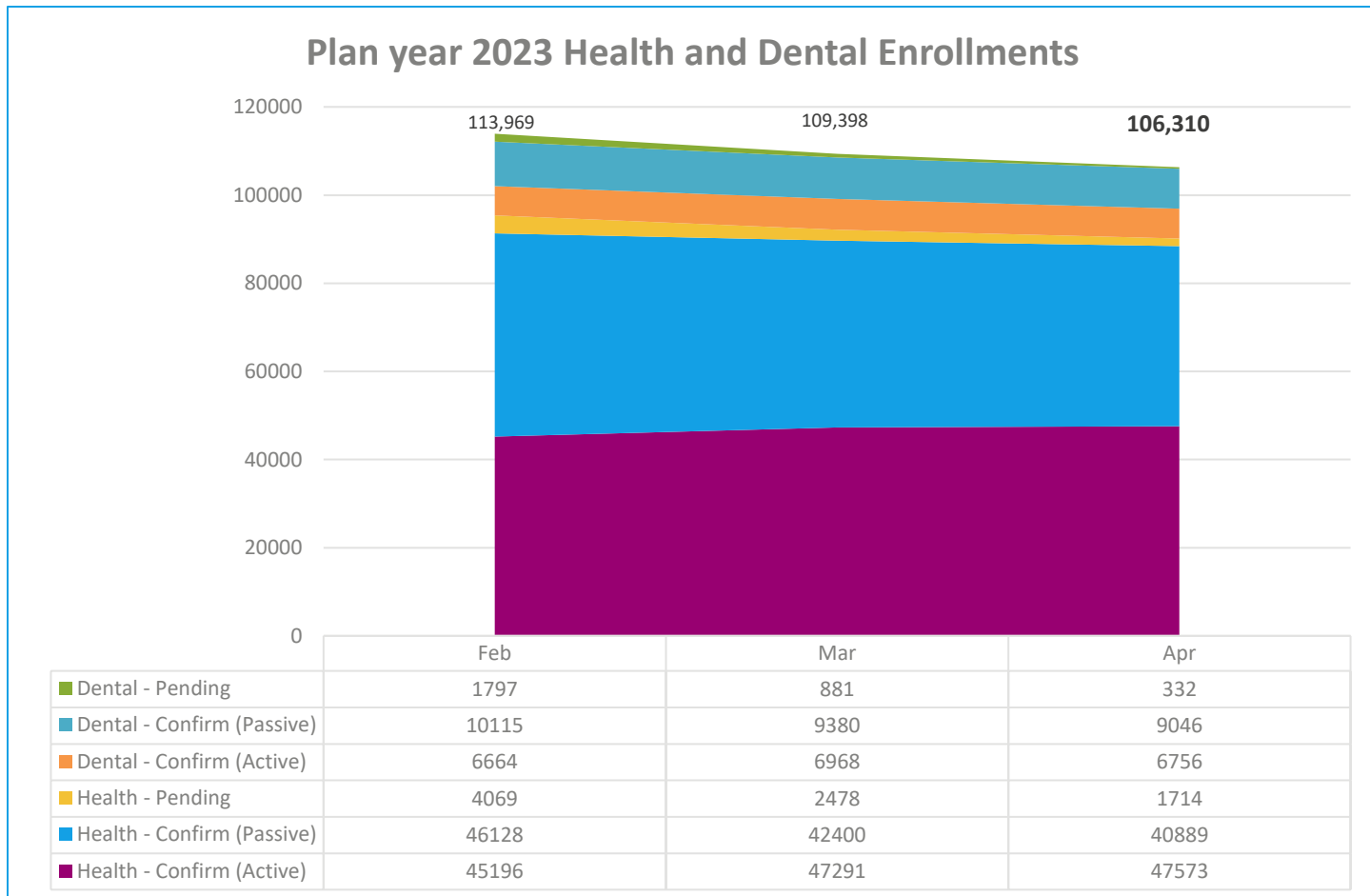

Enrollment Metrics Update

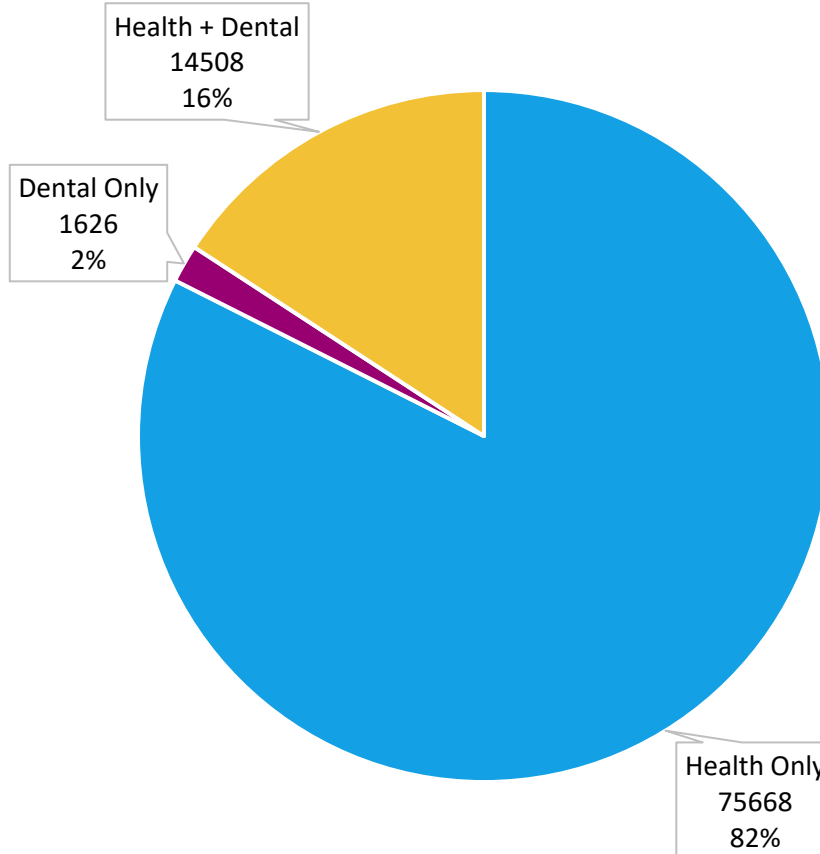
The figures in this table represent Plan Year 2023 Nevada Health Link enrollments in Pending or Confirmed status as of 03/31/2023. Terminated or Cancelled enrollments have been removed from these counts. Please note that consumers who are enrolled in both health and dental plans are counted twice in the monthly totals. A count of unique individuals is provided on the following slide.



Enrollees by Insurance Type

The figures in this chart represent unique, Plan Year 2023 Nevada Health Link consumers in Pending or Confirmed status as of 03/31/2023. Consumers enrolled in Terminated policies have been removed from these counts.

Unique Enrollees for April: **91,802**



Unique Enrollees for March: **94,292**

Plan Cert Update

- The Plan Certification Guide was sent out to all carriers on March 30, 2023. As well as being sent out the Plan Certification Guide has been uploaded to the Nevada Health Link site: <https://www.nevadahealthlink.com/partner-resources/carriers/>
- SSHIX is still currently waiting for CMS to publish Application Materials (Templates). Once those are released, we will ensure all carriers are notified.
- The Plan Certification team is currently in the process of setting up PY24 Plan Certification meetings with all carriers. This will be a quick touch base to talk through any questions or concerns. We want to be more hands on this year to discuss common issues, answer questions and ensure all deadlines are being met in a timely manner.

PHE Unwinding Update*

- SSHIX anticipates receiving the first wave of PHE-related Medicaid/CHIP terminations as early as mid-May, reflecting a 5/31/2023 coverage end date. The earliest that PHE-related consumers are expected to enroll in Exchange coverage would be a 6/1/2023 coverage begin date.
- SSHIX and GetInsured have developed functionality allowing consumers who claim their migrated application and submit a plan selection within 60 days of their Medicaid/CHIP termination date to enroll without a gap in coverage, even if a retroactive coverage begin date is required.
PLEASE NOTE: this functionality is dependent upon corresponding upgrades being implemented by the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services, Nevada's Medicaid/CHIP AE.
- SSHIX has evaluated CMS' proposed 16-month SEP, which would allow consumers who are untimely in claiming their migrated application (i.e. more than 60 days past the Medicaid/CHIP termination date) to enroll in coverage through the FFE, and we are working to implement a similar fallback solution to enroll as many consumers as possible during the PHE unwinding period.
- In addition to a comprehensive marketing plan, SSHIX is hiring additional staff members for our call center to perform targeted outreach to consumers whose Medicaid/CHIP coverage has been terminated, but who have not submitted a plan selection.

*All proposed time frames and functionality are subject to change pending additional federal guidance

Carrier Connector Password Resets

- In recent months the SSHIX Recon Team has been receiving an increasing volume of request to reset Carrier Connector passwords.
- SSHIX recently tested this functionality and confirmed that a manual password reset from our team functions in precisely the same manner as a self-service password reset using the “Forgot Your Password?” link.
- As a result, all carrier personnel who request a Carrier Connector password reset will now receive instructions for the self-service method.

April RCNI Submission

- The next RCNI Submission Deadline is **Thursday, April 20.**
- All carriers are expected to submit both a Plan Year 2023 RCNI in March. Plan Year 2022 is not required.
