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

Enrollment Metrics Update


The figures in this table represent Plan Year 2023 Nevada Health Link enrollments in Pending or Confirmed status as of 06/01/2023. Terminated or Cancelled enrollments have been removed from these counts. Please note that consumers who are enrolled in both health and dental plans are counted twice in the monthly totals. A count of unique individuals is provided on the following slide.

Plan Cert Update

- Review of QHP and QDP Binder submissions are under way, and our initial objections should be sent out by the end of this if they have not yet gone out. Please be sure to check SERFF and respond to objections by the requested date.

- In the May presentation SSHIX described a new initiative intended to provide an aggregated billing solution to Nevada's Tribal Health Clinics, which would allow them to provide a single monthly payment for all of their enrolled members.
- This project will require updates to our Nevada Health Link
 Policy Manual and Annual Issuer Agreement documents, and
 after consulting with our Deputy Attorney General—and also in
 light of the number of stakeholders who will be impacted—we
 believe that a public comment period is the best way to
 develop and implement these changes.
- This comment period will commence upon conclusion of our June 22, 2023 Board Meeting, and will remain open for at least two weeks (exact dates TBD).
- The finalized Policy Manual and Issuer Agreement will be submitted for approval during our July 13, 2023 Board Meeting.



- In addition to the public comment period, SSHIX is seeking preliminary feedback from health issuers prior to the June 22 Board Meeting.
- Janel Davis, SSHIX Operations Manager, recently sent an email to each of your teams with a high-level description of the proposed process, and we are seeking comments and feedback by Thursday of this week, June 15.
- Any suggestions will then be evaluated, and possibly incorporated into our documentation, prior to the public comment period.

PHE Unwinding Update

- On Monday, May 22, the Nevada Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) deployed additional data elements to their referral payloads which allow SSHIX to distinguish between denials of initial Medicaid applicants versus terminations of existing Medicaid recipients.
- These data elements indicate the Eligibility End Date for consumers transitioning off Medicaid/CHIP coverage, which allows the Exchange to automatically validate a Special Enrollment Period for these households without any supporting documentation being required, and also provides these households with the option for an eligibility begin date which falls the day after their loss of Medicaid/CHIP coverage (thereby allowing them to avoid a gap in coverage).
- The SSHIX call center continues to make outbound calls to referred households, and approximately 10% of the households we reach are accepting some degree of assistance. However, overall enrollment numbers remain low.
- In the month of May SSHIX received account transfers for 8,853 households representing 13,115 unique individuals. Of these, 409 individuals had applications that were submitted, 386 were found eligible for QHP enrollment, 294 were found eligible for financial assistance, and 64 were enrolled in health coverage.

June RCNI Submission

- The next RCNI Submission Deadline is Monday, June 19.
- All carriers are expected to submit a Plan Year 2023 RCNI this month. Plan Year 2022 is not required.
