JAMESON: Excellent. And welcome to our new member, Jenny Helton. And I think we would like to start off by checking if we have anybody with public comments.

DAVIS: Madam Chair, Tiffany Davis for the record, I am happy to go ahead and help facilitate our public comments section. I would like to remind those who are on the line who have called in that if you would like to make a public comment, please raise your electronic hand or please indicate in the chat box if you would like to make a public comment. At this time, I'd like to reference to our Carson City conference room. We have Kassie Fuentes in that room. Kassie, do we have anyone in the physical location of the Carson City conference room who would like to make a public comment at this time?

DAVIS: Thank you for confirming that, Kassie. Okay, hearing no abstentions, then we consider those minutes as passed and I would like to move on to our business, which is the fiscal and operational report. Russell had completed this report and it was posted with additions, with edits, which you were all sent in the appropriate times. So, I would like to ask Russell, before we take the vote on passing our final fiscal and operational report to send to the Governor and Director of the Legislature, were there any comments you'd like to make before we ask for motion and discussion?

JAMESON: Okay, very good. So, I would ask for someone to make a motion to pass our fiscal and operational report. I mean, to make a motion to -- yes, to pass that, and then a second.

JAMESON: Very good. A second?

JAMESON: Thank you, Lavonne and Jonathan. And this is an opportunity, after you have reviewed it, if anybody would like to point out any errors or recommend any corrections, additions, edits. Anyone want to discuss anything that is on the report? Any discussion?

DAVIS: Madam Chair, this is Tiffany Davis for the record. My apologies. I did want to bring out that on the cover letter that was posted for the Board to review and then also for the public to see, there is one minor little edit that needs to be made to a date. The letter indicates that the fiscal and operational report would be approved on June 22nd. Obviously, that is incorrect. It's being approved on December 14th. So, I need to make that small edit to that cover letter.

JAMESON: Thank you. And understandable, not an edit that actually is significant in the report itself and we will all take that as a friendly addition edit. So, hearing no other comments or no one desire for any parts to be discussed, then I would recommend we take a vote. And what we'll do here is go ahead and do a hand vote and I'm going to raise my hand cause I can't get my computer working and I'm not going to try to do it on my phone and lose you so.

And, Madam Chair, Tiffany Davis. My apologies again for DAVIS: interrupting just because we do may have some people who are not able to visually see the --

JAMESON: Yes, yes. Let's go ahead and take a roll call vote maybe. DAVIS: That would maybe be a little more appropriate so that ones on the phone, our lines, are able to unhear who is voted as well. Thank you for that consideration.

Okay, very good. So, we will go ahead, everyone in favor JAMESON: then go ahead and let's just say aye, and then we'll do oppositions and abstinence and we'll be able to tell everyone if there's any missed votes. Go ahead and

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everybody in favor of passing the motion for our fiscal operational report, which had the edit of the date as of today, December 14th -- would that be onset or the day it was passed or the day it is implemented?

DAVIS:The day it is passed, Madam Chair.JAMESON:Very good. Can we go ahead and take a vote then?MEMBERS:Aye.JAMESON:Has everyone voted? I can't see hands. I heard a couple.

So, what I would like to do is, I believe the next item on the agenda was that -- Tiffany, our next item after the fiscal operational report we have -- yeah, I'm afraid I'm not able to pull up the agenda.

DAVIS: Yeah. Dr. Jameson, Tiffany Davis again for the record. The next one is discussion and possible action regarding dates, times, and agenda items for future meetings.

JAMESON: Yes. And, Tiffany, I want to thank you for sending out the letter this week and I think everybody saw that the future dates for this coming year, February 20th, it's generally going to be all meetings are still at 1:30, it's going to be on the third Tuesday, February 20th, June 18th, October 15th, December 17th, and those are the current dates and hopefully that will meet with just about everyone so that we can all gather again to review the important business of our Silver State Health Link Exchange. Were there any discussions about future dates or times? COOK: Madam Chair?

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JAMESON: Yes.

COOK: Russell Cook for the record. We wanted to propose the third Tuesday of each month for our meetings throughout the 2024 calendar year. For those unaware, this proposal is driven by a change implemented by the Interim Finance Committee. Historically, they had met on the third Tuesday of each month and there has not been a conflict with our Board meetings. They are changing that and in 2024, they will be meeting on the third Thursday of each month, which given how long those meetings tend to run, means that there will be a risk of overlapping our Board meetings if we don't make a change. So myself and the ex-officio Board members would greatly appreciate your consideration of this proposed change that would allow us to maintain our availability for both.

JAMESON: Russell, thank you for explaining that change and pointing it out because even though I mentioned it's on Tuesdays, it's much clearer when you say it will no longer be on Thursdays and move to Tuesdays. Otherwise that could have gone right over everyone's heads. Thank you. So if there are no other discussions on future dates, times, and agenda items, anyone have any other considerations for agenda items in the February 20th meeting? Thank you. Okay, then I think we can ask for public comment. Was that okay?

DAVIS: Madam Chair, Tiffany Davis, again, for the record to facilitate the public comments. I would like to go ahead and go ahead to our -- I'm sorry, Carson City conference room and ask Kassie once more.
